I. CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Jones stated that he would be willing to pay for the services, Alderman Burnette said no to the idea and Mayor Ron said the board would vote on the topic at the next meeting. Alderman Burnette then brought up the topic of having scheduled repairs done on the following items: patching pot holes, mowing of the grass, and trash pickup. Alderman Burnette also brought up the topic of trailer counts, locking the parks water, and water leaks. The board is also supposed to look at the rates of the dumpsters and vote on them. Pay rates were then brought up in discussion of Chief Sukach, which was then settled on a pay raise to \$22.00, and that was motioned by Alderman Burnette and seconded by Alderman Clement.
