I. CALL TO ORDER

The next topic that was discussed was if we should hire Randy Potts to come in and help train Morgan in QuickBooks. A motion was created by Alderman Price and second by Alderman Burnette to hire Mr. Potts and have him come at his earliest convince to help train Morgan in QuickBooks. Then the board discussed if the CCOC would be allowed to have a Second Harvest mobile pantry at the pavilion at the park, no decision was made on it, but they want Chief Sukach to see about a safe route for the people receiving the food and present it at the next board meeting. They then talked about hiring someone to fix the fence at the sewer plant, and then have TVA reimburse the city, but they decided to have TVA send someone down to fix it. The board wants to get estimates on a new mower, a new roof on the library from licensed and insured contractors, and interest rates on CD's from different banks.
